Three Disaster Recovery Centers to Close Permanently

INDIANAPOLIS – Three Indiana Disaster Recovery Centers (DRCs) – in Utica, Elkhart and South Bend – will close permanently Saturday, June 9, 2018. Survivors do not need to visit a DRC to register with FEMA or get assistance.

- **WHAT:** DRCs offer in-person support to individuals and business owners. Recovery specialists from FEMA, the U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA) and the State of Indiana are available to provide assistance to anyone filling out their applications or updating their status.
- Survivors needing help may call the FEMA Helpline at **800-621-3362 (Voice, 711 or VS) or 800-462-7585 (TTY)**. Helpline numbers are open from **7 a.m. to 11 p.m. ET, seven days a week**.
- **WHEN:** The DRCs are open 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. through Friday, June 8. They will be open from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. Saturday, June 9, when they will close permanently.
