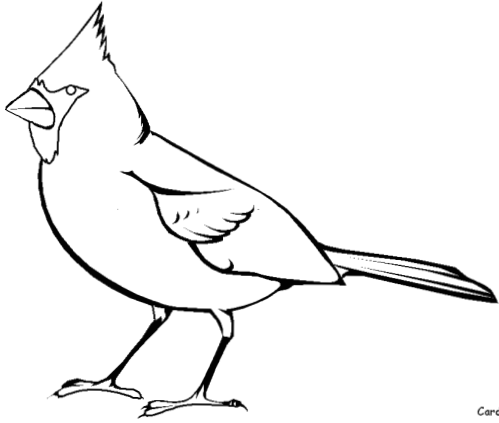

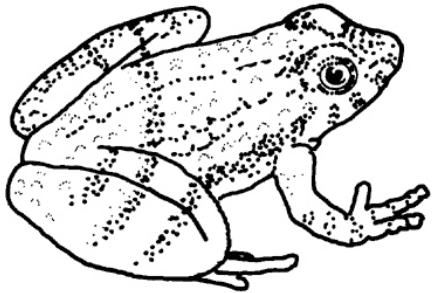


Cardinal

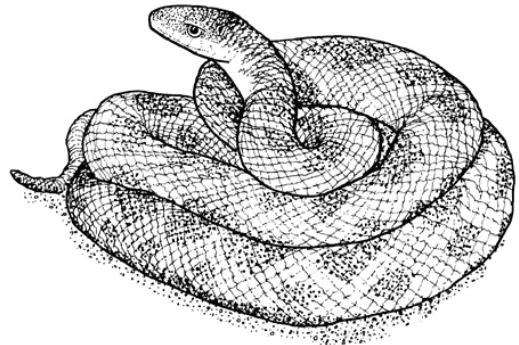
Bird: Cardinal



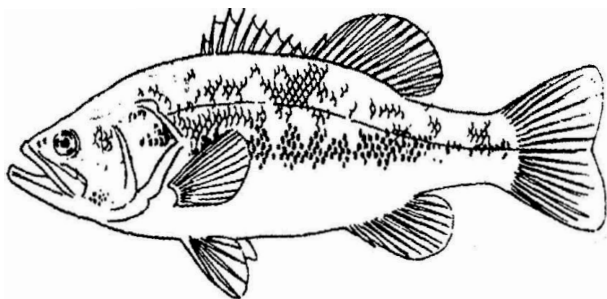
Mammal: Squirrel



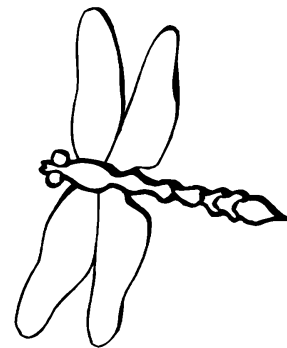
Amphibian: Frog



Reptile: Snake

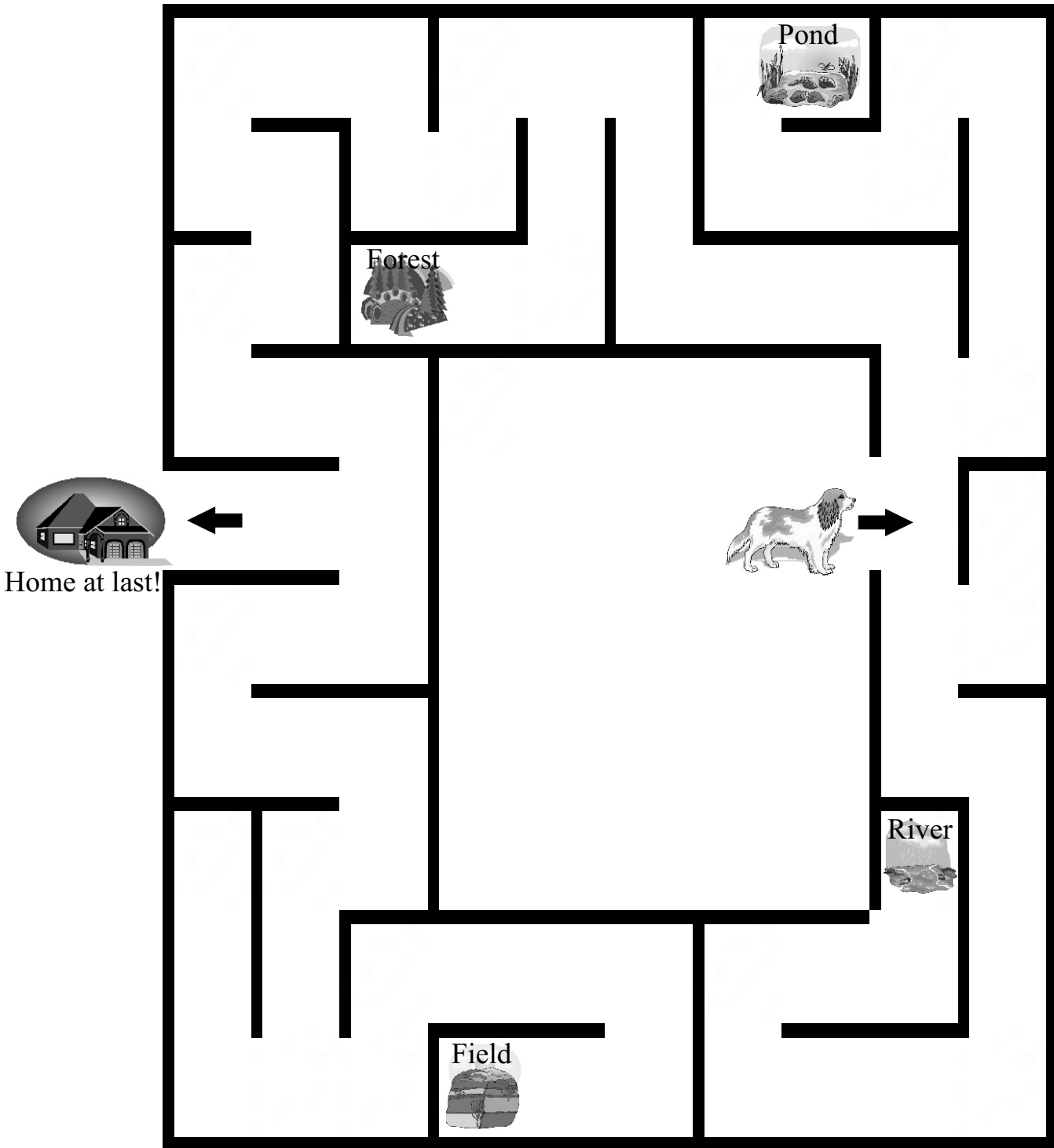


Fish: Bass

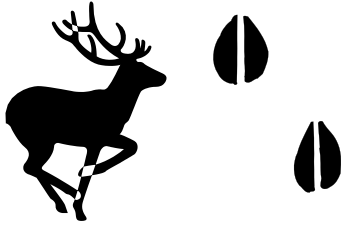
