Dear Sponsor:

For the past two years, the Covid pandemic forced us to make many modifications to our traditional Running Wild event. In 2020, we held a ‘virtual’ event, and in 2021, we held a scaled back version, without the popular post-race celebration. This year, we are planning for a more typical event, and we are cautiously optimistic that we can once again offer all the things about Running Wild that have brought people back year after year.

During the pandemic, our Parks saw a surge in attendance that underscores how important our public lands are to our community. Every year, the St. Joseph County Parks host more than 300,000 visitors and provide the backdrop for outdoor fun for all ages. Area schools rely on the parks for education programs that introduce many children to nature. Community members utilize the parks for regular exercise or to bring their children to the playgrounds for healthy outdoor play. Visitors often find a favorite activity and come back regularly to enjoy it.

**Our public parks play a vital role in the quality of life in St. Joseph County.** We offer a family-oriented, nature-focused destination for area residents to enjoy. We provide well-maintained, affordable recreation spaces and rental facilities for year-round community use. Yet, we know that there are needs for facility upgrades and new programs that often go unmet because of increasing operating expenses and limited budget dollars. Running Wild and other events and programs help us raise funds through the St. Joseph County Parks Foundation (SJCPF) to enhance the programs we provide to the entire community.

*The mission of the St. Joseph County Parks Foundation (SJCPF) is to ensure that our county parks remain strong and vibrant despite the challenges we face. **On August 20, 2022, the SJCPF will be holding our 10th annual Running Wild event at St. Patrick’s County Park.*** This outdoor gathering features a 5K timed run on park trails along with a 3K wacky scavenger hunt/nature walk perfect for families. We are looking forward to hosting the hundreds of enthusiastic runners and walkers who traditionally mark their calendars for Running Wild every year.
