

Ferrettie/Baugo Creek County Park

This park opened in 1987, after the Board acquired and developed sixty-five acres of land just east of Osceola on the northwest corner of U.S. 33 and the Elkhart County line. Another fifty acres of islands and marshlands in Baugo Bay came under control of the Parks through a long-term lease with the Indiana and Michigan Electric Company. With other purchases, this park comprises over 214 acres of forest, meadow and riverine habitat, picnic areas, hiking trails, disc golf, boat launch and winter tubing.

Interpretive programs on the fur trade and pioneer skills are also offered.
